## **Interpreter Strip Requirements**

Youth and adults may wear this strip if they show their knowledge of a foreign language or sign language by:

- 1. Carrying on a five-minute conversation in this language.
- 2. Translating a two-minute speech or address.
- 3. Writing a letter in the language (does not apply for sign language).
- 4. Translating 200 words from the written word.



## **Morse Code Interpreter Strip**

Youth and adults may wear this strip if they show their knowledge of Morse code by:

- 1. Carrying on a five-minute conversation in Morse code at a speed of at least five words per minute.
- Copying correctly a two-minute message sent in Morse code at a minimum of five words per minute. Copying means writing the message down as it is received.
- 3. Sending a 25-word written document in Morse code at a minimum of five words per minute.

The interpreter strips are worn above the "Boy Scouts of America" or "Scouts BSA" strip on the uniform.
